Damages were found in 10 sections of the cemetery, which was opened in 1875 as part of the city's Preobrazhenskoe (Transfiguration) Cemetery and has at least 80,000 burials.

-- At least 50 gravestones in the medieval Jewish cemetery in the German city of Worms were smeared with a green paint. Among the vandalized gravesites was the tomb of Rabbi Meir of Rothenburg, known as the Maharam, a prominent rabbi who died in 1293.
